During this camp, we want to see you grow in these areas to become a family of influence and impact.

FAMILY COSTS:

Administration fee paid with your application form \$25.00/family

Camp Fees (motel): (children of 2 yrs and above)

Adults (16 yrs and over)	\$165.00 each
Children (2-15 yrs)	\$110.00 each

This includes all food, accommodation and materials for the six nights of camp. Cabins 25% disc Caravan 30% disc. Under 2 free.

STAFF FEES:

Staff fees are for those who have been before and are coming back to serve, or for new staff.

Adults (16 yrs and over)	\$155.00 each
Children (2-15 yrs)	\$100.00 each

Couples will have their own room. Singles may be sharing with others.

We need lots of staff to run a camp, for childcare, organizing equipment, running games, prayer support and mentoring couples. Any age can serve.

THE PROGRAMME:

Throughout the week there will be times of dynamic learning in families, age groups, through intergenerational games, sharing within the family, worship, service and free time.

Each day has a different focus that is supported by fun games, teaching and family challenges. Day 1: The Individual. Day 2: The Couple. Day 3: Inviting God into our Family. Day 4: The Family as a Team. Day 5: How can we be a Source of Blessing.

About 70% of your time will be spent with your own family learning and growing together. The children go away into 3 age groups sessions to be taught the same, age appropriate, content as the parents receive in their teaching times, then return to discuss.

The Camp is best suited to families with one or more children aged six years or more. Families with younger children are of course welcome, but they need to be aware that it will be harder to participate in some activities, although the camp will be very helpful in building good foundations for your family. The camp is well suited for families with teenagers also. Single parents are welcome and catered for within the camp. The programme is full and exciting but also allows for time to reflect and relax with other families. During camp we have 2 afternoons off where families are given 3 hours free time to connect and relax together.

Every family that has participated has commented that the Families of Faith camp was a very worthwhile investment in their family.
